Inclusion as we know it...

The aim of the three-year project is to mobilize the HE capacity in Armenia and Bosnia and Herzegovina in contributing to the implementation of the SD strategies through capitalizing on knowledge transfer.

The project **objective** include:

- Capacity building of HEI staff and respective governing bodies at PCUs for desinging and implementing SD strategies
- Development of a master plan for the two HE sectors to foster contribution to implementation of SD strategies
- Development of institutional support mechanisms for implementation of SD strategies
- Fostering access to HE for persons from vulnerable/underrepresented groups

Networking

The project consortium was established having partners from Armenia, B&H and EU that ensures a better learning platform through diversity of experiences.

Capacity building

A series of trainings, workshops, consortium meetings, study visits and site visits were conducted to enrich the capacities of the staff engaged in the project implementation, to share experience and gain first-hand information on the best practice, as well as to ensure the smooth flow of the project and its progress. Different partner institutions from Armenia, Bosnia and Herzegovina and Europe hosted the events to promote active dialogue between the participants introducing them their culture and experience on inclusive education. All the meetings ensured better understanding between the consortium members creating a collaborative and friendly atmosphere to reach the desired goals and develop further cooperation.

Local dissemination

To ensure the project outputs and outcomes are visible among the stakeholders of the field a series of dissemination activities were carried out by the project partners including publication of articles on websites, organization of the round table discussions and staff capacity building activities. Two field-wide conferences were held in Armenia and B&H to raise awareness on inclusive education among other institutions and create new platform for further discussions of the inclusion issues.
